The main features of the call

- Attracting, retaining, and developing young talents
- Strengthening excellence through the implementation of a research project
- Supporting training and professional development of postdoctoral researchers
- Exposure to various sectors, disciplines, and international contacts (internships in other institutions)

Profile of a young researcher

- an individual up to 8 years after obtaining a doctorate, assuming full-time engagement in research after receiving the degree
- previous experience, competencies, and skills aligned with the proposed project
- the evaluation includes their achievements, such as participation in projects, internships, publications, patents, mentoring younger colleagues, attendance at training sessions and conferences.
- the <u>mobility rule</u> stipulates that the researcher cannot spend more than 12 months within 36 months before the final deadline for submitting the application in the country where they intend to undertake the internship, in this case, Poland.

HORIZON-MSCA-2024-PF-01-01

Budget

For researchers: living allowances (in Poland 3581 euro/pm), mobility allowances (600 euro/pm), family allowances (660 euro pm)

For institution: research, training, and networking costs, management and indirect costs

An extra important feature of the call

ERA Fellowship call component – parrallel to MSCA PF Call (only for Widening countries like Poland)

The application to the (MSCA) Postdoctoral Fellowships 2024 will be automatically resubmitted to this call in case the proposal fails to reach an adequate place in the ranking to be funded (but thresholds must be passed)

Additional information about the call

Secondments

- Postdoctoral Fellowship recipients have the option to incorporate a secondment phase during the fellowship, allowing for international experiences in any country. The secondment can be a continuous period or split into shorter mobility periods.
- In the context of European Postdoctoral Fellowships, secondments are limited to one third of the total requested duration of the fellowship (excluding any additional period for non-academic placements). They must align with the project objectives, contributing significant value and impact to the overall fellowship.

Placements in the non-academic sector

up to six months to undertake non-academic placements supporting R&I projects, fostering cross-sector career moves, innovation, and knowledge transfer within the EU Member States or Horizon Europe Associated Countries
